### VBS TRAVELS TO PERU THIS YEAR

The children will hike cloud-shrouded ruins of Machu Picchu, savor exotic flavors of the Amazon, and hear what daily life is like for kids in Peru. They will gather for crafts, music, games, snacks and more starting at 9 a.m. and continue through the 10:15 worship service. Other VBS days include July 9, 23; Aug. 13, 27.

All children are welcome here, but we know that a fussy baby is much louder to a parent's ears than to any of ours. If you have need:

- We have a nursery down the main stairs and to the left. It is staffed with volunteers, who will gladly care for any little ones who show up at the beginning of the service. If there are none, the volunteers will come up to the sanctuary, the nursery room will remain available. There is also a diaper change station in the Nursery and in both downstairs restrooms.
- We have a speaker in the narthex so that you DIY soothers can listen while you walk the little ones around.

Except on communion Sundays, there is Children's church for ages 4 through grade 2. When there is Children's church, children will be dismissed after the Children's Time part of the service.
